



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

NARUC Andean Regional Partnership Supports Electrical Interconnection, Power Market Integration

With support from the Bureau of Energy Resources' Power Sector Program (ENR/PSP) of the United States Department of State, NARUC is working with Andean governments to provide regulatory tools and share best practices that support the development of cross-border power projects, the evolution and development of a regional electricity market, and renewable energy integration. In June 2021, NARUC formally launched the ENR/PSP-NARUC-Andean Regional Partnership with a four-part webinar series on regional market development that ran from June 17 – July 15.


